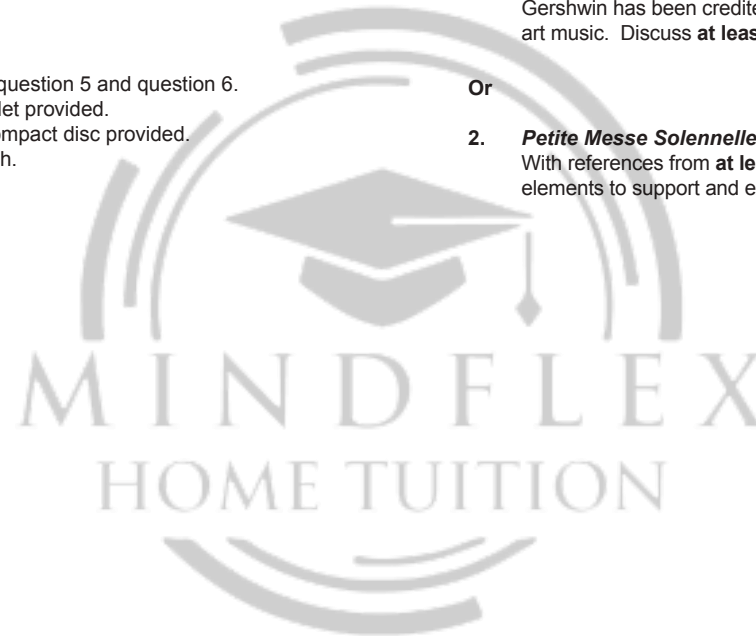
1. *An American in Paris* by George Gershwin

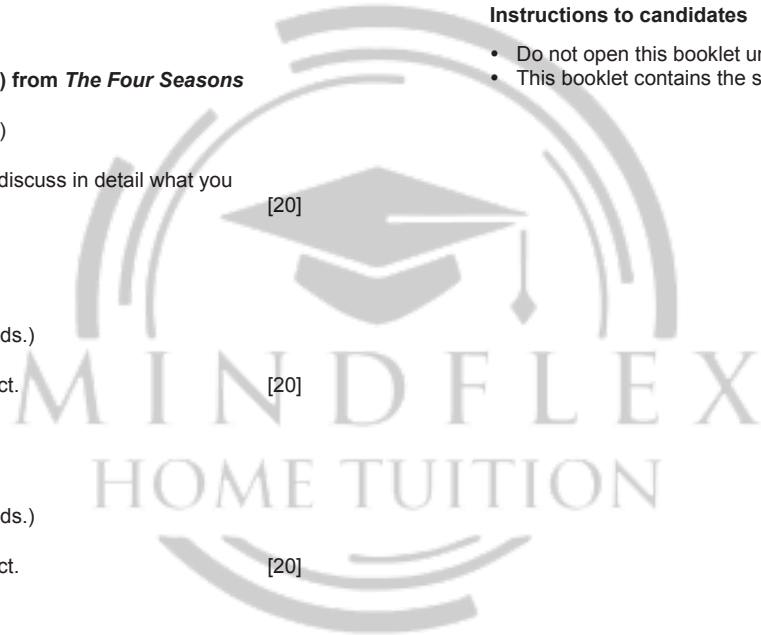


